Two things define the current youth: rebelliousness and music. This is shown through the Electronic Dance Music and Hip-Hop. And there is only one thing that combines the two: BTS also known as Bangtan Sonyeondan or the Bulletproof Boy Scouts.

Originated in 2010 with seven young and handsome Korean boys; Kim Namjoon, Kim Seokjin, Min Yoongi, Jung Hoseok, Park Jimin, Kim Taehyung and Jeon Jungkook was from South Korea, the band debuted in 2013 and nine years later, they are regarded as one of the biggest names in K-pop world. Not only are they popular, their lyrics are well written with delicate themes of mental health, teenage issues and individualism. Their success did not just come to them immediately, it took a lot of effort to become the most popular boy band in the world.

The boys were first discovered by Big Hit Entertainment, a South Korean entertainment company in the fall of 2010. Before turning into a band, they started as trainees for Big Hit and received coaching to be what they are today. Their rigorous training took them almost three years before making their debut. They debuted in 2013 as a hip hop group. Along the way, their musical style evolved to include a wide range of genres. Their first official album as a seven-member K-pop idol group, "2 Cool 4 Skool" reflected their message in the title song of their first album, "No More Dream". The group's second album, sold one million copies in South Korea. By 2017, BTS crossed into the global music market, leading the Korean Wave into the United States and breaking numerous sales records.

BTS was breaking records with their diverse genres and soon, garnered several recognition to their name. BTS is the best-selling artist in South Korean history and holds the best-selling album in South Korea with 'Map of the Soul: 7'. They are the first Asian and non-English speaking act to be named Global Recording Artist of the Year 2020, Billboard's Top Touring Artists of the 2010.

They sold out Wembley Stadium and Rose Bowl Stadium for their 'Love Yourself' World Tour as well as SoFi Stadium and Las Vegas stadium for their 'Permission to Dance' tour this year. As of March 2022, they have won 63 awards in total and remain the only artist as well as the most-awarded in South Korean history to do so. The group's numerous achievements also include 9 American Music Awards, 12 Billboard Music Awards, 28 Golden Disk Awards, and nominations for 2 Grammy Awards and 2 Brit Awards.

The reasons for their ever growing success were their connection to the youth in a deeply personal way and becoming their broken voice. The band gradually started gaining recognition and their fans began uniting as "A.R.M.Y" (Adorable Representative M.C for Youth). Over the years, they started performing at concert tours and witnessed tremendous commercial success.

Outside of music, they partnered with UNICEF to establish the Love Myself anti-violence campaign, addressed three United Nations General Assemblies, and became the youngest ever recipients of the Order of Cultural Merit from the President of South Korea due to their contributions in spreading Korean culture and language.

Exotic Animals

A Arachnids and Insect Pets

More and more people are keeping large arachnids and insects as exotic pets. Large insects like Madagascar hissing cockroaches and stick insects are some of the popular exotic pets. Tarantulas are growing in popularity as pets as well. Despite their enormous size, they are harmless to humans. They have mild venom and can usually be held in your hands without any issue. One reason they are sought after as pets is that they are easy to maintain as they only need to be fed insects once a week. Scorpions are another exotic pet type. The most common scorpion pet is the Emperor Scorpion. Like tarantulas, Emperor Scorpions do not possess venom which are lethal to humans and are relatively harmless.

B Norwegian Forest Cat

Norwegian Forest Cat is a large, semi-longhaired cat whose rugged appearance fits its name. Despite the hardy look, this breed is very much a homebody that enjoys the company of other pets and particularly their human companions. Their relationships with you can best be described as "on their own terms." Yes, Forest Cats can be lap cats, but they will decide when to get on or off your lap. These are moderately active cats; there will be bursts of energy followed by long naps. Sensitive yet social, you will find them to be intelligent cats that adapt readily to change.

C Sugar Glider

Sugar gliders are often called flying squirrels due to their body structure, size, and prominent tail. Adults are generally 6 to 8 inches in length and weigh between 4 and 6 ounces. They have thumbs like humans which are called opposable digits that help them keep their grip. Their short, soft coat appears grey with black stripes and a white belly. Selective breeding in captivity and genetic mutations in the wild have also produced white and cream-coloured gliders. Their small size, calm nature, longer lifespan, and amusing acrobatic skills are just a few facts that make them appealing household pets.

D Flowerhorn Fish

The Flowerhorn fish can be best described as an opportunistic omnivore. It is not particularly picky about what kinds of food it eats. In captivity, plant-based food in any form including pellets compose part of its diet. It particularly enjoys peas, lettuce, and spinach. This should be supplemented with a protein-rich diet consisting of worms, shrimps, crickets, grasshoppers and other insects. Owners will need to feed them around two or three times a day. Flowerhorns are voracious eaters and will pretty much consume almost anything you feed them, so try to limit their calorie intake a little to prevent weight gain. Flowerhorn fish are sometimes considered to be signs of fortune, luck, health, and prosperity by collectors.

E Ferret

Ferrets sleep 14 to 18 hours a day and enjoy sleeping in enclosed areas such as cages. They mark territory by dragging their rear ends across the ground or spraying their urine. The anal gland which produces the unpleasant musk is surgically removed in some parts of the country before they are sold. This procedure called descenting is considered unnecessary mutilation in many countries. Ferrets sleep so deeply that one can hold, poke and yell at them and they will not wake up. This is called being "ferret dead asleep," a behaviour resulting from their need to rest after playing for some time. They enjoy dancing for joy, wrestling and chasing each other which is an amusing sight for pet owners.
